
## Villanova Theatre: Audition Notice

- All choreography will be created in collaboration with the director, actors, and fight choreographer or intimacy choreographer.
- Actors will have the opportunity to indicate any questions or concerns about the moments listed above on their audition form.
- Prior to rehearsing scenes involving intimate contact, actors, director, stage manager and intimacy choreographer will discuss content, consent, and boundary practices. All moments of intimacy and fight choreography will be staged in accordance with the guidelines outlined in the Villanova Theater Graduate Handbook.

# Important Scheduling Information Crazy for You

#### **Important Schedule Notes:**

- A read-through/sing-through will occur on Saturday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>. Please note that this is the end of the Fall semester.
- A Dance Workshop will occur on Sunday, December 3<sup>rd</sup>. Additional dance workshops/rehearsals will be scheduled in the Fall semester. More information will follow.
- Rehearsals in January will begin on Tuesday, January 9<sup>th</sup>. Please note this is before the start of the Spring semester. Those cast in the show will need to return early from Winter break. Anyone with on-campus housing will need to apply to come back early from Winter break.
- The typical rehearsal schedule is Tuesday through Friday evenings, daytimes Saturday and Sunday, with Mondays off. Additional days off may be scheduled by the director.
- Tech week is mandatory and will occur February 8<sup>th</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, Feb. 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Performances occur Wednesday, Feb. 14<sup>th</sup> through Sunday, February 25<sup>th</sup>.
- Strike occurs following the show on Sunday, February 25<sup>th</sup>.
